## Tuition Payment Plan

The Tuition Payment Plan allows you to pay your tuition in installments each month of the term. Fall and Spring term will consist of 3 payments and Summer term will consist of 2 payments. To take advantage of the Payment Plan, **complete this form and return it with your first payment to the Student Financial Services Office by 5 p.m. on the first Friday of the trimester. There is a \$50 service fee added to the first payment for the plan.** All subsequent payments are due on the first Friday of each month. Payments made after the due date will be assessed a late fee for each late payment. The first payment must be made by the due date to qualify for the plan.

**Payment Plan conditions:**

- A \$50 service fee is charged.
- A new Tuition Payment Plan must be submitted each term.
- Eligibility will be rescinded and registration put on hold if tuition is owed for previous terms.
- Most forms of payment are accepted including credit and debit cards.
- A \$25 fee will be charged for any checks returned from the bank for insufficient funds.
- First payment is due with this form submission
